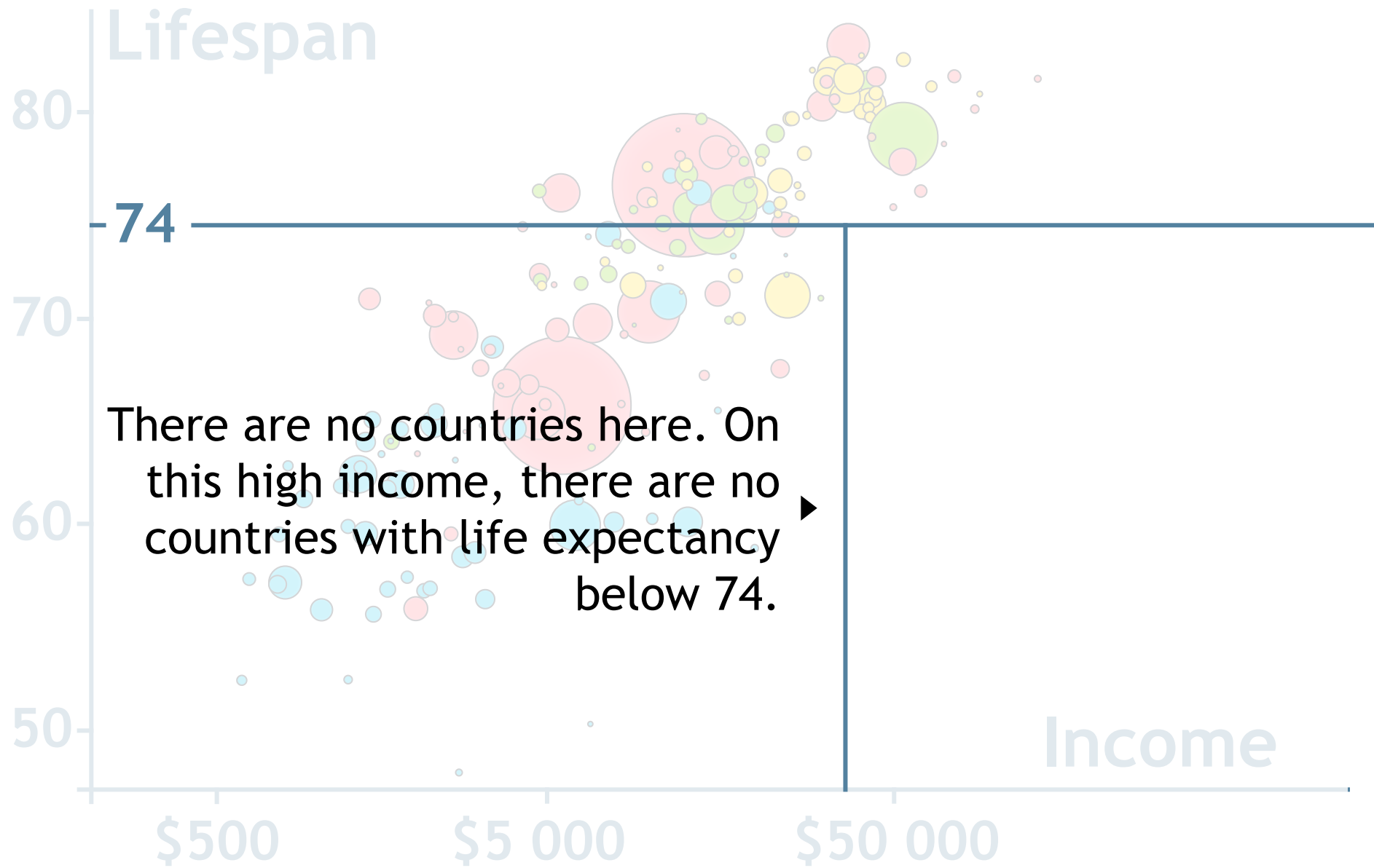

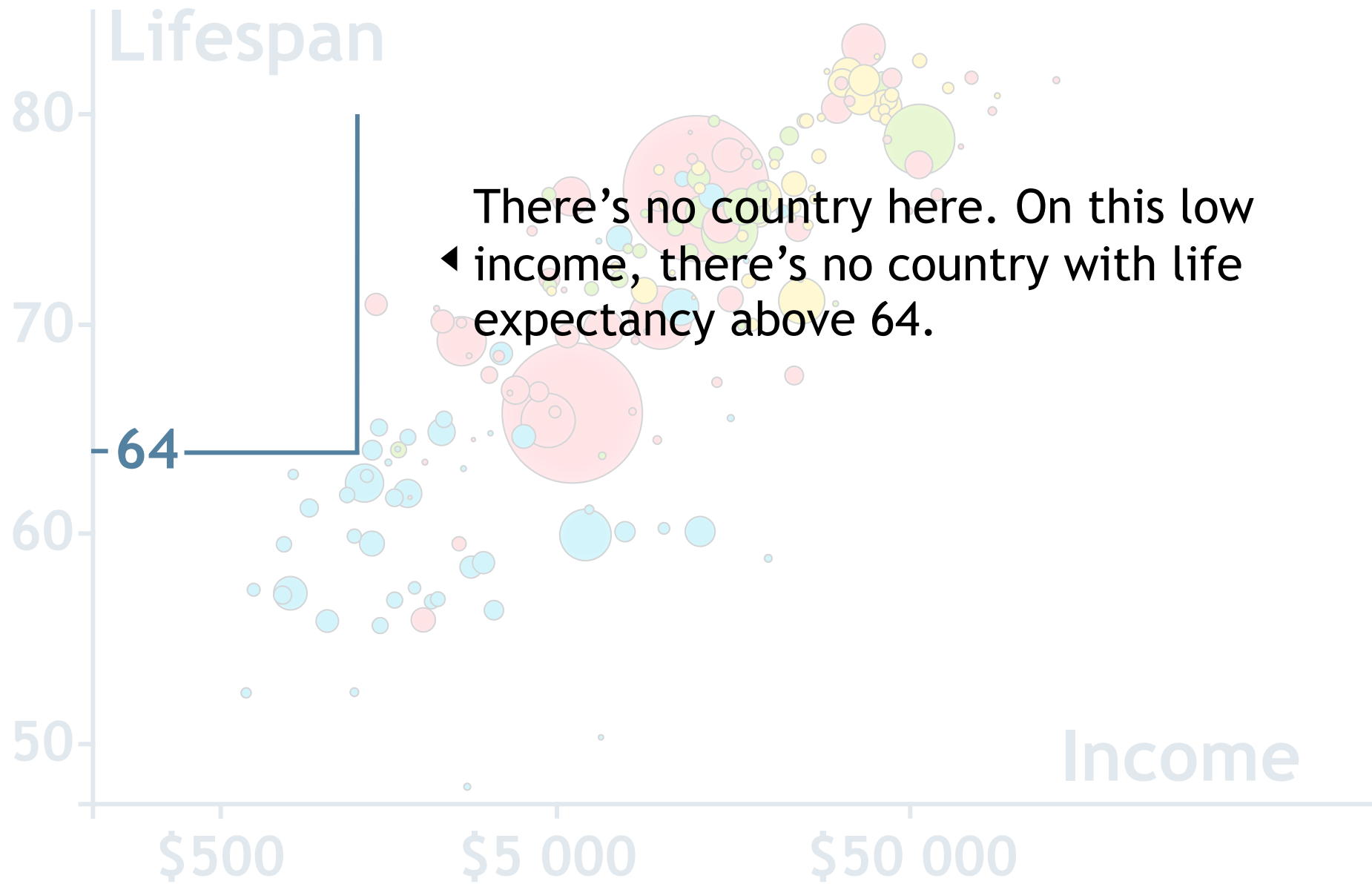

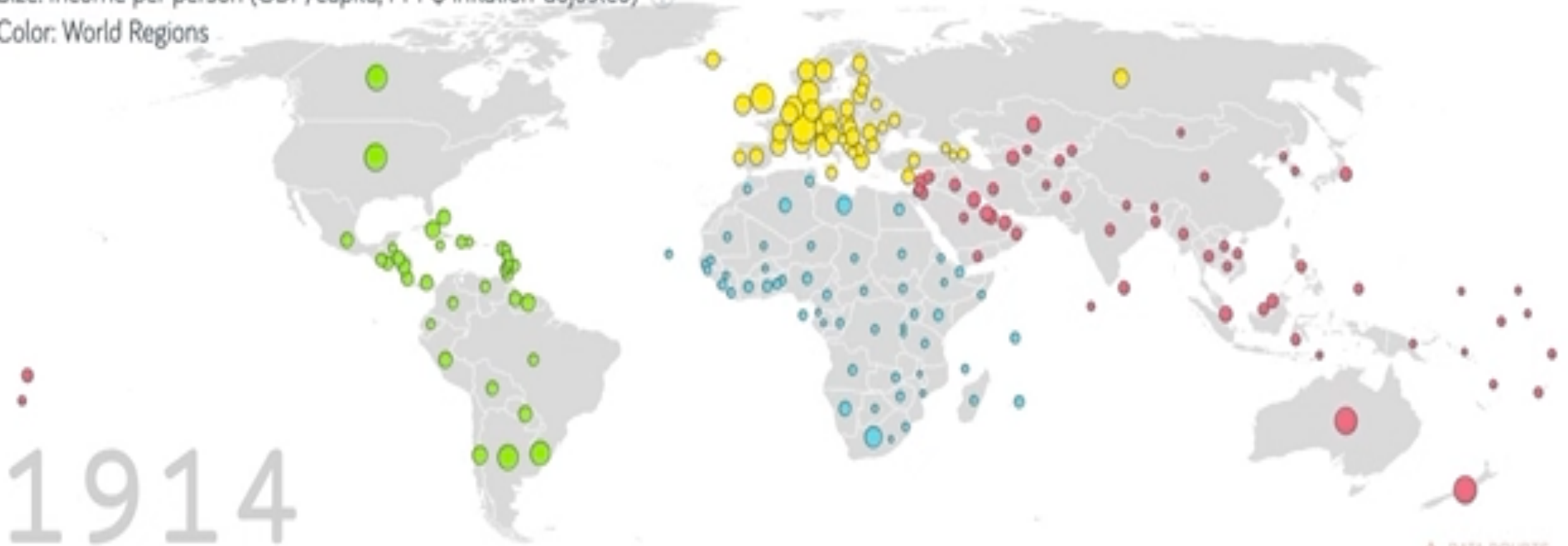
– How Does Income Relate to Life Expectancy?

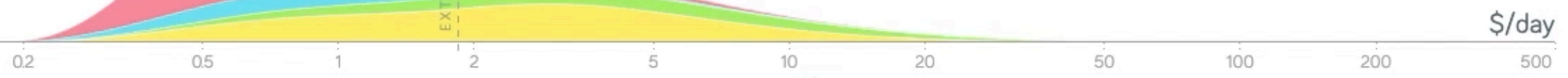
